


Become A Kingdom Builder

PRAY FOR OPEN DOORS

Many missionaries work in countries that are difficult to access or in areas that are resistant to the gospel. Pray...

That God will open doors of ministry, blessing partnerships and friendships.

That those who serve will be led by the Holy Spirit and recognize open-door opportunities.

That God will lead His people past barriers to hearts ready to receive His Word.

PRAY FOR PROTECTION.

In some countries, missionaries may be exposed to the possibility of danger and personal harm. Pray...

That God will keep ministers and missionaries safe.

That God will change the hearts of those who are resistant to His Word.

PRAY THAT GOD'S WORD WILL SPREAD

Obstacles must be removed to allow God's Word to spread rapidly and freely, and missionaries need the strength to continue in the face of opposition and difficulties. Pray...

For strength and stamina as missionaries encounter antagonistic spiritual forces (Ephesians 6:10-18)

That people will resist Satan's plans to obstruct the spread of the gospel (James 4:7)

That God's Word will spread rapidly and be honored wherever it goes.

PRAY FOR EFFECTIVE MINISTRY

It's important to rely on God for all aspects of ministry - especially during times of great difficulty so that efforts will produce fruit and ultimately a harvest will be gathered. Pray...

That God will provide strength and perseverance when their ministry seems to be fruitless.

That seeds will be planted and ministers and missionaries will be able to see the fruits of their labor.

That an abundance harvest will be produced as more people learn about the love of Christ.

PRAY FOR REFRESHMENT

Ministers and Missionaries deal with many of the same stresses you face in life, like overwhelming workloads, conflicts in relationships, and financial uncertainties. Living and working cross-culturally adds an additional element that can challenge their emotional, spiritual, and physical vitality. Pray...

That God will provide opportunities for them to spend time with other believers.

That God will provide times of peace and relaxation to refresh His workers.

For restoration - physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually - that can only be found in Jesus.

PRAY FOR MORE KINGDOM BUILDERS

Matthew 9:37-38 says, "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask Him to send more workers into His fields." Pray...

For willing and obedient hearts to respond to God's call to serve.

For a spirit of generosity and sacrifice among God's people.

For the necessary training and resources for those who are called to GO.

For spiritual, emotional, and physical preparation for the missions work ahead.

For God to make ways where there seem to be none and to lead workers to the places where they are most needed.

For God to remove any fears or doubts that may hinder those whom God has called to GO from stepping out in faith.

For financial provision and for churches and communities to rally around and support those the Lord is calling.

For the Lord to reveal to you all that He is calling you to do as we as a church Pray, Give, and Go.

BGMC

BGMC (Boys & Girls Missionary Challenge) engages, teaches, and disciples our youngest generation in God's mission to reach the lost. This is accomplished by creating a heart of compassion in kids for the world's and our missionaries' needs. Kids are challenged to pray for our missionaries, sacrificially give to missions, and reach the lost here in our own area.

This goal is reached by kids filling their Buddy Barrels and bringing them to the Epic Kids Missions Sunday, which is the 4th Sunday of each month. During this monthly missions service the kids not only hear a special lesson on a different country being supported by the BGMC ministry.


Epic Kids has set a goal to raise \$2,000 for BGMC in 2024 and we are currently almost one-fourth of the way to our goal!



SPEED THE LIGHT

Speed the Light (STL) is a program that not only supports missionaries but also fosters a heart for missions among young people. STL is more than just a fundraiser but rather an opportunity for students to make a tangible impact on the spread of the gospel worldwide - a key discipleship tool that supports missionaries around the world with the equipment and resources they need to live out the calling God has on their lives. By discipling students through generosity, the lost can be found, the broken restored, and communities can be changed forever.

Heritage Youth has set a goal to raise \$5,000 for Speed the Light in 2024 and has currently raised a total of \$294. For this year's project, they are working to raise money for water filters to provide clean water to local families and to raise money to purchase paint and other small construction supplies, which will be used on the Heritage Youth Missions Trip to Guatemala in 2025!

We are excited to announce four different mission trip opportunities, which are taking place over the next 18 months! We invite you to prayerfully consider joining us as we go and minister to the people of the Amazon and the Ivory Coast. The recommended age for each of these trips is 18+.

Ivory Coast Construction Project & Kids Outreach with Missionary Brent Teague.

When: Sept. 30 - Oct. 8, 2024 Where: Ivory Coast, West Africa Approximate Cost: \$3,000.00

Mission: To construct a church and kid's building, prividing a place for the people of the Ivory Coast to grow in their reltionship with the Lord

and each other.

Peruvian Amazon Medical Missions, Ministers Training & Kids Outreach with Crossroads Medical Missions

When: Approx. February 22 - March 1, 2025

Where: Peruvian Amazon

Cost: Approximately \$2,250/person

Mission: To combine medical missions, local minister training, and a kid's outreach event, seeking to address the physical and spiritual needs of

the people and pastors of the Amazon.

Peruvian Amazon Construction Project & Kids Outreach with The Peruvian Call

When: Sept/Oct 2025 (Exact Dates TBA)

Where: Peruvian Amazon

Approximate Cost: \$2,500/person

Mission: To combine church construction with a kid's outreach event, seeking to build relationships, faith, and hope in the Peruvian Amazon.

Heritage Youth Goes Global

When: Mid-Late July 2025 (Exact Dates TBA)

Where: Guatemala

Approximate Cost: \$1,600/person

Make plans to join us as we partner with Childhope and missionary Kenny Horton to serve the people of Guatemala. The mission of Childhope is the transformation of children through a relationship with Jesus Christ, a quality education, and other ministries of compassion. As we partner with this ministry, we will be painting, doing light construction for schools and churches, and doing kids' ministry outreach events. This trip is open to all students ages who have completed 6th - 12th grades.

Missionary Kenny Horton will be joining us at Heritage Church on Sunday, October 27, 2024. This will be a great opportunity for parents and students to meet the missionary we will be working with and to hear more about the heart and mission we will be supporting!
